# GUN WRAP PAPER

## NOTICE

Brownells, Inc. cannot guarantee rust and corrosion protection for any specific length of time when using either the methods outlined in this Instruction Sheet or any others and assumes no responsibility for damage which may occur to wood, metal or plastic finishes when Gun Wrap Paper is used.

## CAUTIONS

- (1) Gun Wrap Paper will not damage blued finishes or bare steel.
- (2) Copper, bronze and brass with less than 20% zinc content will not be protected or harmed by either contact with Gun Wrap Paper or exposure to its vapors.
- (3) Polished, unanodized aluminum and polished silver surfaces can develop minute surface corrosion from direct contact with Gun Wrap Paper or its vapor.
- (4) Nickel and Nickel Plated steel, zinc brass (with more than 20% zinc content), cadmium and cadmium plated steel may develop corrosion or surface discoloration when in direct contact with Gun Wrap Paper but will be protected and unharmed by Gun Wrap vapors as long as direct contact between the metal and Gun Wrap is avoided.
- (5) Older nitro-cellulose lacquer and some varnish finishes on wood may be damaged by direct contact with Gun Wrap Paper. These finishes may also react with a plastic bag. Please test carefully and if there is any doubt, avoid use.
- (6) Wash hands after handling Gun Wrap and do not allow direct or vapor contact with any foodstuff.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF GUN WRAP PAPER

- (1) Each 12x12 Sheet or 4x36 Strip of Gun Wrap Paper is designed to provide a minimum of 2 years (usually 10-15 years) protection against rust and corrosion for 1 cubic foot (1728 cubic inches of space under sealed, airtight, inside storage conditions. For the purpose of these instructions; use of Brownells No. 1 Long-Term Storage Bag (½ cubic foot) for hand guns and tools, and Brownells No. 2 Long-Term Storage Bag (1 cubic foot) for long guns, will be assumed.
- (2) Vapor phase protection extends to 18" from the Gun Wrap Paper. All metal to be protected must be no farther than 18" from the sheet of Gun Wrap Paper.
- (3) **To protect handguns and tools with Gun Wrap Paper in Brownells Long Term Storage Bag No. 1 or equivalent sealable container.**
- (4) Cut one 12x12 Sheet or one 4x36 Strip in half... use one piece per No. 1 Bag. Seal remaining piece(s) and unused sheets tightly in their original shipping package to prevent loss of effectiveness.
- (5) Lay guns/tools on, or wrap them in, the ½ sheet of Gun Wrap Paper and place inside the Storage Bag. If contact with the paper is to be avoided (see "Cautions" above) separate stored items from Gun Wrap Paper to prevent direct contact.
- (6) Seal bag or container airtight to ensure maximum effectiveness.
- (7) **To protect long guns with Gun Wrap Paper in Brownells Long-Term Storage Bag No. 2 or equivalent sealable container:**
- (8) Use one 4x36 Strip per No. 2 Bag. Seal remaining Strips tightly in their original shipping container to prevent loss of effectiveness.
- (9) Spiral wrap the barrel and action with Gun Wrap Paper, or lay Gun Wrap Paper next to the gun in the bag. If contact with the paper is to be avoided (see "Cautions" above) separate Gun Wrap Paper and gun to prevent direct contact.
- (10) Seal bag or container airtight to ensure maximum effectiveness.
