

Brownells "Insta-Grip" is a non-slip, adhesive backed tape that will provide additional, positive gripping surface when applied to any firearm. Insta-Grip is flexible and can be applied to a variety of shapes including rifle/shotgun forearms, recoil pads, and pistol/revolver grip frames, barrels, underlugs and backstraps.



## WARNING



Never attempt to disassemble or reassemble a firearm unless you are absolutely certain that it is empty and unloaded. Visually inspect the chamber, the magazine and firing mechanism to be absolutely certain that no ammunition remains in the firearm. Disassembly and reassembly should follow the manufacturer's instructions. If such instructions are not immediately available, contact the manufacturer to see if they are available. If they are not available at all, then you should consult other reference sources such as reference books or persons with sufficient knowledge. If such alternative sources are not available and you have a need to disassemble or reassemble the firearm, you should proceed basing your procedures on common sense and experience with similarly constructed firearms.

## **HOW TO USE**

Cut the tape to the desired shape with a pair of heavy duty scissors. Place the Insta-Grip tape on the firearm and check the fit. DO NOT PEEL AND STICK until fit is checked. Be absolutely sure of the position of the tape because once it is applied it is very difficult to remove. Make sure all edges of the tape will lay flat and have enough surface area to adhere to. Avoid sharp corners or creases in the tape. Insta-Grip will not stick to oily or wet surfaces. Degrease and clean the area of any oils, moisture or contaminants that will keep the tape from sticking. CAUTION: Take care when using solvents to degrease gun stocks. Some stock finishes (e.g. linseed oil base stock finishes) are not resistant to most solvents. If possible, test the solvent on a small area of the gunstock that will not be noticed (i.e. under the recoil pad or grip cap). After cleaning the area to be covered, peel the backing paper from one edge of the Insta-Grip and locate the piece by pressing only the exposed edge of the tape onto the area with finger pressure. Closely observe the location of the tape and adjust the location as necessary. If the location is acceptable, remove the rest of the paper backing and press the tape down with firm, finger pressure.

Reassemble the firearm according to the manufacturer's instructions. Check for proper functioning using ACTION PROVING DUMMIES. Make sure ALL SAFETY MECHANISMS are fully functional as designed and approved by the manufacturer. If these tests prove satisfactory, test-fire the firearm with live ammunition in a SAFE and APPROPRIATE manner.
